

Student Behavior Expectations LaPorte High School Extra Curricular Events

LPHS is excited to welcome Slicer fans to our exciting athletic competitions. Expectations for student behavior at LPHS events are based on safety and promoting a positive atmosphere. School rules apply on campus and during all school sponsored activities/events whether at home or at another school or facility. LPHS asks parents to help our efforts to promote a safe and fun environment by reviewing these expectations with their students.

Grade 6, 7, & 8 students are encouraged to attend events with a parent/guardian. High school students are encouraged to sit in the student section. All students must always exhibit good sportsmanship and represent LPHS in a positive manner.

As a condition of attending LPHS activities and events all students must acknowledge an understanding of the rules and regulations that govern student behavior at all school sponsored events (home and away). Students may be removed from the event not complying with rules and regulations. Students are also reminded that they could face disciplinary action that results in suspension or recommended expulsion from school for engagement or participation in any of the following behaviors (this list is not comprehensive):

- Vulgar, obscene, profane language, writing, and/or behavior
- Throwing any object that could be considered unsafe for spectators and attendees
- Any type of horseplay (including tag, tackle football, climbing trees, etc.)
- Possession of tobacco, alcohol, or substances against school rules and in accordance with state law.
- Possession of any weapon or dangerous object
- Vandalism of school property
- Riding skateboards, bicycles, rollerblades on school property
- Bullying, harassing, or threatening behavior (including electronic)
- Any behavior considered unsafe and/or inappropriate

All students need to exit the facility/stadium following the game. Loitering is not permitted.

Students may not possess a backpack at school events. Students must follow the directions of LPHS staff members the first time they are given. In the event a student is removed from a school activity the parent and principal of the student will be notified.
