

COVID 19- Orange Spread Level Information for LPCSC Families

If the County COVID-19 Spread level moves to Orange, the following programming details will apply for what is now, in person instruction:

- Traditional students will attend in person Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Traditional students will participate in remote learning on Tuesday and Thursday.
- No change for Distance Learning Academy student schedules.
- No change for Homeschool Academy student schedules.

Child Care During Orange Level Programming

- Child Care will continue to be provided for families already enrolled in the program **IF** the district is operating in “Orange” COVID spread level programming.
- The hours of Child Care will be: 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays only (during Orange COVID spread level programming). The remainder of the week (M, W, F) Child Care hours will operate normally before and after school, 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 2:45 p.m. to 6 p.m.
- The Tuesday/Thursday sites for child care will be Crichfield and the Kesling Campus. Riley and Kingsbury child care programs will meet at Kesling Campus on Tuesday/Thursday **IF** the district is in “Orange” COVID spread level programming.
- Students in child care will be expected to complete remote learning activities as assigned by the classroom teacher.

Orange Level Instruction on Tuesdays and Thursdays

- **Student Daily Assignments:** Students will be expected to complete remote learning activities as assigned by the classroom teacher. Assignments will be posted, Loom videos will be assigned, and Zoom videos will be scheduled by teachers. Students should log into Canvas or Google Classroom each morning by 8 a.m. to communicate with their teacher(s), and complete assignments to be counted present in the daily attendance. Assignments will be due the same day as the lesson unless otherwise communicated by the teacher. Teachers will be available 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 5-6 p.m.

- Student Activities: Extra-curricular activities will be limited for grades K-6 during Orange programming with practices and events held only on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
- Activities scheduled at La Porte Middle School for grades 7-8 and La Porte High School for grades 9-12 will continue on Tuesday and Thursday as scheduled unless otherwise notified by the school.
