Important Information about Second Semester Distance Learning Schedules

Please note that distance students may have less than seven courses in their schedules due to the impossibility of offering every LPHS course in both a distance and in-person format. Guidelines & Expectations for Second Semester LPHS Distance Learning:

1.
