HOW DO I ENROLL MY CHILD?

Parents/guardians must complete and sign a permission form to enroll each child under 18 years. Students 18 or older can sign permission forms for themselves. Submit the completed form to your child's school, and he/she will be eligible to receive all services at the Slicer Health Clinic for the La Porte Community School District 2018-2019 school year.

INSURANCE will be billed; if uninsured, assistance in enrollment to appropriate government insurance will be coordinated.
